Less than 10% of high school graduates receive any financial education in school. In 2004, undergraduates had an average outstanding credit card balance of \$2,169 (Source: USA Today). The average outstanding balance on graduate student credit cards is \$8,612, an increase of 10% from the 2003 average of \$7,831. ( Nellie Mae Grad Student & Credit Cards in 2006, published 8/07).

Money is the number one cause of divorce in America. Money is among the top reasons people commit suicide. Approximately 75% of Americans live financially month to month.

The rules of saving for retirement have changed, from pensions given to employees after many years of

dedication to employees being completely responsible for saving for their own futures.

Up until now, our focus on educating kids about money has been left up to parents who often know little about how to make and manage their own finances.
